

## State Permitting FAQs

### 1. What is the Arizona State Permitting Dashboard?

Arizona's State Permitting Dashboard is a public website that provides a single location for owners of large, complex infrastructure projects to submit their projects for permitting considerations, collaborate with the state in identifying required permits and track the progress of each permit required for their projects.

### 2. What is the benefit of participating in the permitting program?

The Permitting Dashboard provides transparency into the permitting process to improve coordination between project sponsors, state agencies and stakeholders, thereby ensuring all required permits are obtained and projects are ready to start.

### 2. Are all infrastructure projects publicized on the AZ State Permitting Dashboard?

No. It is strictly a volunteer program, and only eligible projects submitted through the State Permitting Dashboard site are considered for publication.

### 3. What makes a project “eligible” for the State Permitting Dashboard?

Eligible projects must:

- a. Be a construction project that involves infrastructure in one of 11 infrastructure categories
- b. Have a total construction investment of \$25M or greater
- c. Be subject to applicable state environmental laws

### 4. How do I submit a project for the program?

Simply submit the information on the [Submit a Project](#) page, and we will take it from there.

### 5. What happens after I submit my project?

The Government Transformation Office will review the project information and if there are any questions, GTO will reach out to the project sponsor. The project information will also be reviewed by agencies to verify which permits are required by the state of Arizona. Once the information has been reviewed and it is determined that the project is eligible for the State Permitting Dashboard, the project sponsor will be notified when the project is published.

### 5. When will my project be published on the dashboard?

No later than 75 days from time of submittal.

**6. Will company information be published on the dashboard?**

Only the company name will be published on the dashboard.

**7. What project information will be published on the State Permitting Dashboard?**

The project title, project description, project permits and milestone descriptions and dates.

**8. How do I know which permits are needed for my project?**

After a project has been submitted via the State Permitting Dashboard, the project will be reviewed by the Government Transformation Office and permitting agencies to determine permits needed for the project.
